Larry Myers has been an ordained pastor and worship leader/musician since 1975 when he helped establish the original Vineyard Christian Fellowship. The focus of his ministry has been the pastoral care of artists and musicians enabling him to serve as a mentor to worship leaders and musicians throughout Southern California. Larry is a prolific musician specializing in mandolin, violin, viola, and cello and has recorded or performed with members of the Rock and Roll Hall of Fame, Gospel Music Association Hall of Fame, Louisiana Music Hall of Fame and Grammy, Tony, and Dove Award winners. Among the many artists and musicians he has recorded or performed with are Bob Dylan, Greg Lake (King Crimson, "Emerson, Lake, and Palmer"), T-Bone Burnett, Bernie Leadon (Eagles), Tommy Funderburk, John Patitucci, Ramblin' Jack Elliott, Johnny Rivers, Ryan Bingham, Laura Hall (Who's Line is it Anyway?), Chuck Girard, Annie Herring, Bob Bennett, Bruce Carroll, Scott Wesley Brown, Wayne Watson, Michelle Tumes, Billy Sprague, Brenton Brown, Scott Waara, David Ruis, Kevin Prosch, Terry Clark. He was an original member of the Chuck Girard Band. He appeared frequently on the Vineyard worship series "Touching the Father's Heart". In addition to his work as a studio and performing musician, Larry plays regularly with worship teams at several churches and leads a regular gathering of these worship leaders.
